

ST MARY'S ECO TIP - BUTTERFLIES

The nationwide Big Butterfly count is on. To take part just spend 15 minutes on a sunny day in the garden or the countryside and count how many butterflies you see. This wet spring has not been good for butterfly numbers but it is still important to chart changes in distribution.

There is a chart to download from the Butterfly Conservation Trust to help identify butterflies, and results can be submitted to bigbutterflycount.org or via the big butterfly



count app. The count ends on 4 August but if we miss that the iRecord Butterflies app allows us to submit at sightings butterflies at any time.

A butterfly hunt adds interest to a family walk and we may be lucky to spot common blues or the rare Adonis blue on Malling Down or the silver washed fritillary in Laughton woods. RINGMER WI UPDATE

Our speakers in July were Dorry and Linda from the Horsham team of Days for Girls, a charity that aims to increase access to menstrual products and vital health information for women and girls around the world.



After telling us a little about the stigma, superstitions and taboos which result in many children and women being isolated while they are bleeding, the speakers showed us the handmade, washable, reusable menstrual kits that are built to last.

Each kit, made from colourful cotton, contains a protective shield, absorbent liner, panties and other items in a drawstring bag, all designed to be easily washed. The UK team alone has made and distributed in the order of 24,000 kits around the world.

The organisation also provides health and sex education to both girls and boys, and supports local social enterprises so that women can make kits for themselves and their communities. Dorry and Linda were warmly thanked for their inspiring presentation of the work of this amazing charity. Head to daysforgirls.org for more information.







Ringmer Against Greenfield Exploitation

Thanks to all who turned out for the CPRE meeting. With standing room only and good questions for the Lewes Planning

lead, the District councillors who attended should have plenty to think about. There's a change in the expected process: instead of a second consultation, LDC is planning to go directly into preparing the new draft Local Plan, to be published sometime in the autumn. That means that the plan and the consultation comments after its publication go straight to the inspector appointed to examine the local plan – that's the next point at which we can have formal influence. We'll do our best to keep you posted! Meanwhile, you will no doubt have seen the DON'T URBANISE RINGMER placards appearing in the village – if you've not applied for one, don't delay, do it today. If you are waiting for one already ordered, don't despair, we'll get to it! Go to ringmergreenfields.org for more information.

FINGERPOST FIELD - SKATEPARK AND PLAY PARK

The new play park is now open and being enjoyed. Work on the skatepark continues and should be finished towards the end of August. There will be an official opening when both are operational.

We have been granted Lewes District Council (LDC) Community Infrastructure Levey (CIL) funds of £50,000 towards the play park and £75,000 towards the skatepark, with a further £45,000 from the

Caburn developer contribution.

PICNIC ON THE GREEN - MONDAY 26 AUGUST 1PM TO 5PM

We are planning another Picnic on the Green on August Bank Holiday, Monday 26 August 2024. The event starts at 1pm and there will be a Dog Show, Live Music, Food Stalls, Licensed Bar and Games. NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN REVIEW

The Ringmer Neighbourhood Plan 2020 was adopted on 16 September 2016. It is currently being reviewed with the help of a Steering Group. The main purpose of the Steering Group is to oversee the Neighbourhood Plan Review for the Parish of Ringmer in order that this will then progress to Independent Examination and a successful community referendum and ultimately be adopted by Lewes District Council to become Planning Policy.

The Steering Group will engage the local community to ensure the plan is truly representative of the ambitions of the Parish of Ringmer and will maximise support for the approach taken in the Neighbourhood Plan by ensuring high levels of community engagement throughout the plan-making process.

The Neighbourhood Plan Review Steering Group meets for the second time on 15 August 2024. There will be consultation along the way, hopefully in early Autumn. This will be a chance to contribute your ideas and to let us know how you feel the village should be shaped in the future.

LEWES DISTRICT COUNCILLOR EMILY O'BRIEN UPDATES

"I've written to Laurence Gosden, the CEO of Southern Water to ask him the following. Firstly, which proposed projects to prevent sewage spills in Ringmer will still go ahead given the hole in Southern Water's improvement budget (NB this is still the highest water company bill increase in the country!). Ringmer Neaves Lane Treatment work currently discharges unacceptable levels of untreated waste water into the Bulldog, and hence Glynde Reach and the Ouse, and this situation can only worsen with the levels of development on the horizon.

"Secondly I've asked Mr Gosden how he can possibly justify his large executive bonus given the gap in the budget for Southern Water undertake crucial works and their ongoing performance failures. I await his reply with interest."

Text from the letter to Laurence Gosden of Southern Water, which has also been copied to local news outlets.

Dear Laurence Gosden

As a Lewes District Councillor with a lead on water quality, please could you confirm:

- 1. Whilst still allowing Southern Water to increase bills by more than any other water company in the country, Ofwat has not approved the increase you requested. Given the resulting reduced budget for addressing water quality, please can you clarify which of the proposed improvement works in our district including at Ringmer, Barcombe, and Lewes Ham Lane (the 2nd highest sewage spiller in the southern water region) will be going ahead, and which will not.
- 2. Please can you explain the logic of restarting executive bonuses including a payment of £183,600 to yourself, given the ongoing performance issues. Please note that I do not accept the logic used in your press statement that these payments will be taken out of 'shareholder dividends' as clearly all bonuses are taken out of any profit made by the company and Southern Water have in any case quite rightly suspended shareholder dividends. It is a false logic to argue that you as a company do not have the choice to reinvest profit back into crucial infrastructure works, rather than pay out to yourselves, and given the above hole in your budget following Ofwat's decision, I do not see how such bonuses can be justified.

RINGMER PAST TIMES



Continuing the series of old photographs of Ringmer, courtesy of Ringmer History Group.

This shows Delves House in 1893, with new owner Aubrey De Putron standing by the front. The medieval house had been refronted in the 18th century. De Putron, who had rented Delves House for several years before his purchase, immediately added an elaborate patterned-brick facade, and made

substantial additions to the rear service areas of the house.

In 1935 John Christie bought the house, and promptly demolished the medieval part of the building. His Ringmer Building Works replaced it by a modern structure. He retained much of De Putron's service wing, the oldest part of the house that still survives today. For some years Delves House was a genteel residence, and for a period after the war it was let to the conductor Sir Thomas Beecham. Then in 1953 it was let to the County Council as an Old People's Home.

In 1983 the County Council gave up their lease, having built a new, larger care home at 37 Harvard Road. The Delves House site was then redeveloped to its present format by a Glyndebourne company.


