



RINGMER REPAIR CAFÉ UPDATE

The steering group of seven people met on 19 June to start making key decisions related to setting up a Repair Cafe for Ringmer.

Everything, including the venue, costs, initial funding and opening a bank account needs to be explored. However, we first need to encourage many more people to come forward to create small teams able to repair

small electrical, wooden, ceramic and mechanical objects, audio and IT equipment, clothes and textile repairs and much more.

ST MARY'S ECO TIP FOR JULY – SAVE FUEL, MONEY AND THE PLANET WITH ECO DRIVING

Although walking, cycling and public transport are all much better for us and the planet, petrol and diesel cars are here for a while yet. How much fuel you consume depends

on the car you buy, but here are some tips to slash your usage.

- Extra weight in the car, including roof racks and boxes, means extra fuel consumption. Pack carefully to reduce drag, or remove altogether.
- Change up earlier if the car has a manual gearbox try changing up at an
 engine speed of around 2,000 rpm (diesel) or 2,500 (petrol). Since 2014, new
 cars have been fitted with a gear shift indicator to encourage use of the
 most efficient gear.
- Cut down on the electrics turn off your rear window heater, demister fan and headlights when you don't need them.
- Stick to the speed limit going faster uses more fuel. Drive at 70 mph and you'll use up to 9 per cent more than at 60mph and up to 15 per cent more than at 50mph.
- Don't leave the engine running when sitting in your parked car!

NORLINGTON LANE SOLAR FARM

OVESCO's Chris Rowland gave a short update to the Parish Council about the proposed solar farm: "In December 2022, the connection date for Ouse Valley Solar Farm was delayed by ESO National Grid.

We have been waiting for National Grid to develop a queuing

system and agree with the District Network Operators (UKPN in the Southeast), if and where connection dates could be brought forward. Projects waiting to connect, which included the Ouse Valley Solar Farm, were assessed and those deemed at the front of the queuing system were requested to send in an Expression of Interest form, confirming they wished to connect earlier. OVESCO submitted its Expression of Interest to UKPN at the end of May. We are now waiting to see if the connection date can be brought forward."

Contnuing the series of old photographs of Ringmer, courtesy of Ringmer History Group.

This image shows the Ringmer Congregational Chapel as it was in 1907. In 1914 this timber-framed chapel (probably the original one built in 1835 by the timber merchant James Berry) was demolished and replaced by the brick chapel on the

Lewes Road that still survives today. The Ringmer chapel closed in 1995 and the building was converted to residential use. The group gathered outside the chapel here are the Sunday School children, about to set out on their annual summer treat, usually a picnic with games on the Downs.

The Ringmer chapel was established by members of the Lewes Tabernacle, an impressive Georgian building that stood where the Lewes Pedestrian Precinct is today. In 1954 the decision was taken to demolish the Tabernacle building, and it was replaced by the new Christ Church on Prince Edwards Road, Lewes, today run by the United Reform Church.
